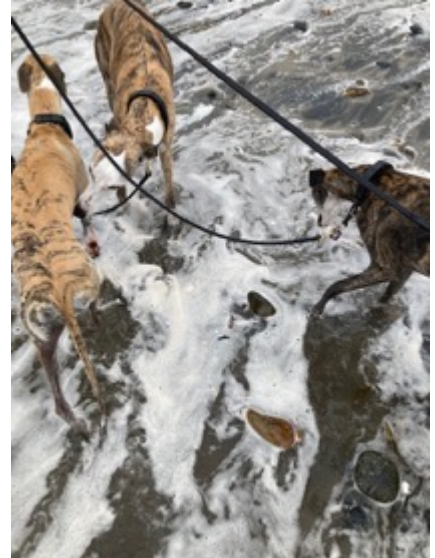

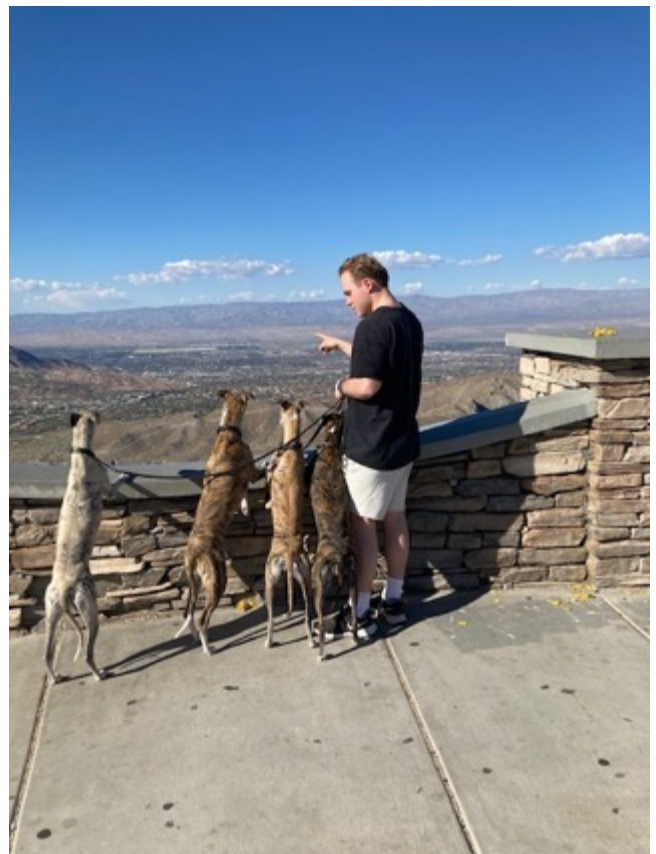

his age.

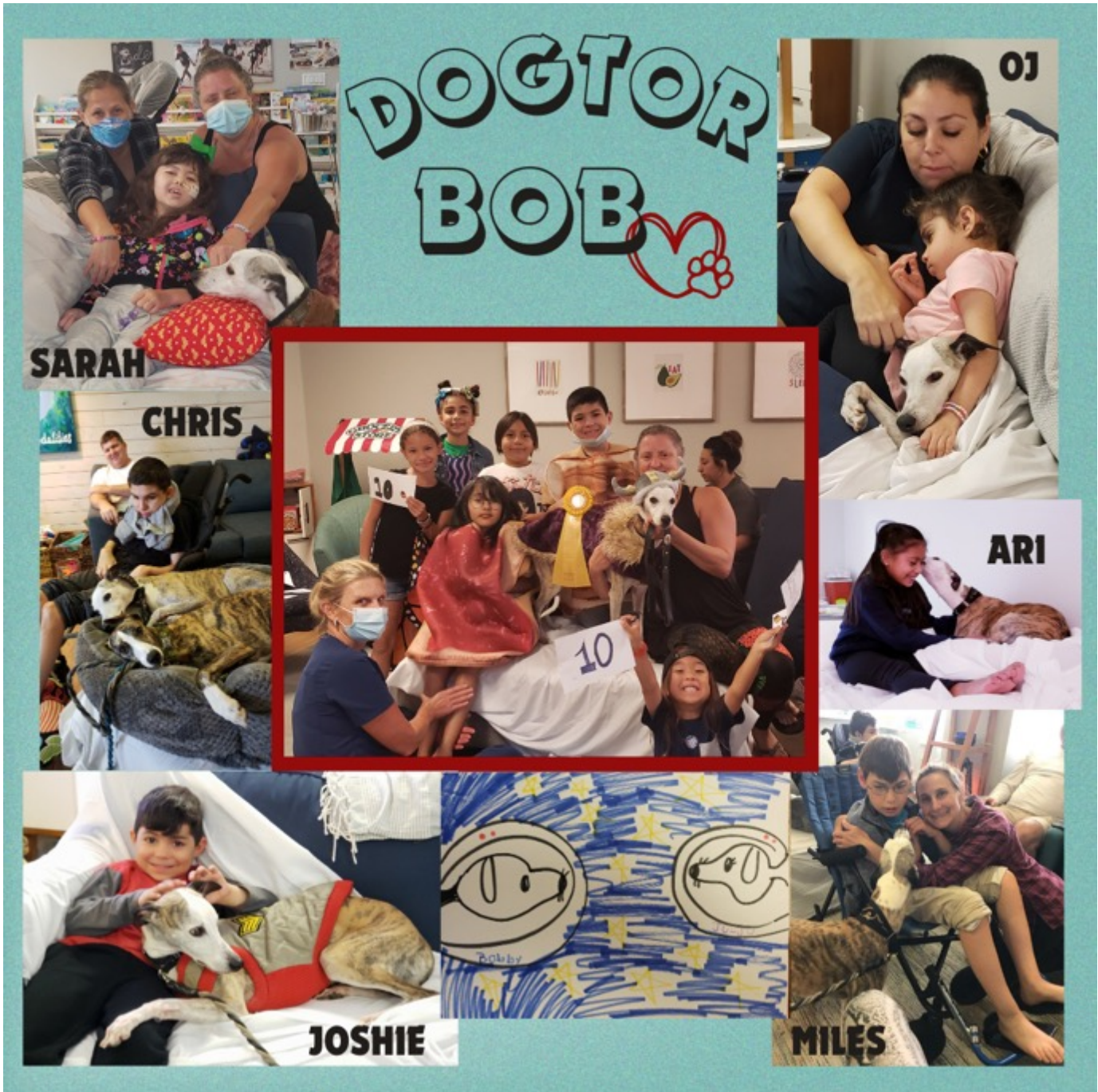


Tangens Fly Me To The Moon
